#### IOWA CONFERENCE MEN'S GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP PREVIEW

**CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA...** The 2004 Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IIAC) men's golf Championship begins this weekend, April 23-24, with the first 36 holes of the 72-hole Championship. The first two rounds will be held at Gates Park Golf Course in Waterloo, Iowa. The final 36 holes will be played April 30-May 1, at Ellis Park Golf Course in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. Friday rounds begin at 11:00 a.m. and Saturday rounds begin at 9:00 a.m. Coe College is the host of the 2004 men's golf Championship.

On the first day of the Championship, Central, as the defending Champion is seeded #1, and its players will play with golfers from the second and third seeded teams. Teams are seeded based on the averages from its four best 18-hole team scores during the spring. Players from the fourth, fifth and sixth seeded teams play together as do players from the seventh, eighth and ninth seeded teams.

Pairings for play in rounds two and three will be based on the team score position from the previous day. The final round pairings will be determined by individual scores after round three.

**2003** Championship Team Recap: Central won its third straight IIAC golf Championship and 24<sup>th</sup> in the last 28 years with a four-round total of 1232, edging second place Luther by four strokes. Loras finished third with a 1240, two strokes better than fourth-place Wartburg. Buena Vista and Simpson tied for fifth with a 1257.

**Top Returning Players:** Simpson's **Mike Martin** was the only golfer to shoot under 300 last year (297) and became the first Storm golfer to earn individual medalist honors since 1970. He is one of seven top-10 finishers from 2003 that return this year. The other returning All-Conference performers include Loras' **Pete Weber** (3<sup>rd</sup> with a 302) and **Adam Luehmann** (5<sup>th</sup> with a 304), Wartburg's **Kevin Ault** (6<sup>th</sup> with a 305, won playoff), Central's **Kyle Matzen** (7<sup>th</sup> with a 305, lost playoff), Coe's **Josh Ketter** (8<sup>th</sup> with a 306) and Central's **Nick Grossman** (9<sup>th</sup> with a 208).

Grossman also earned All-Conference honors in 2002 with a sixth place finish and is one of three top-10 finishers from that year competing in 2004. Wartburg's **Shaun Guyer** placed seventh after losing a playoff with Grossman and Central's **Alex Schenfeld** finished tenth while playing for Simpson. Central's **Pat McElyea** (8<sup>th</sup>) and Wartburg's **Dan Schmitz** (11<sup>th</sup>) were All-Conference performers in 2001.

Other 2003 top-20 finishers returning to this year's field include: Buena Vista's **Alex Downing** (t-19<sup>th</sup>), Central's McElyea (13<sup>th</sup>), Cornell's **Adam Majeski** (14<sup>th</sup>), Wartburg's Dan Schmitz (t-16<sup>th</sup>), Guyer (t-16<sup>th</sup>) and **Andy Schmitz** (t-19<sup>th</sup>).

A review of each school's performances at tournaments during the spring 2004 season follows along with the stroke average and top-18 hole round for each individual expected to participate in the Conference Championship.
