IOWA CONFERENCE MEN'S TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIP PREVIEW

CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA... The 2004 Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IIAC) men's tennis Championship will take place Thursday-Saturday, April 22-24, in Cedar Rapids. Luther College is the host of the 2004 Championships that will be played at Clark Racquet Center on Coe College's campus, at Veterans Park and Noelridge Park. Should inclement weather force the matches indoors, the indoor courts at Coe and Westfield Tennis Club will be used.

The three-day event will feature an eight-team Dual Team Championship on Thursday, a three-flight singles Championship and a two-flight doubles Championship on Friday and Saturday.

Team Championship: The eight-team dual team Championship, which was seeded by a vote of the Conference tennis coaches conducted following the conclusion of the regular season, begins at 8:30 a.m. on Thursday. Three-time defending Conference Champion Coe College is the top seed. The Kohawks have a 23-1 overall record including three victories against Division I opponents. Central College, with a 16-7 overall record and a 5-1 IIAC mark, is the #2-seed followed by two-time runner-up Luther College (15-12 overall, 4-2 IIAC).

The remaining seeds for the Team Championship are: #4 Simpson College (11-6, 7-3), #5 Wartburg College (8-11, 5-6), #6 Cornell College (6-12, 4-5), #7 Loras College (7-7, 5-4) and #8 Buena Vista University (2-11, 1-9).

The dual matches will conclude once a team wins four matches and are played out to determine place finishes one through eight. Should the Team Championship not be completed on Thursday, it will be completed prior to the start of the Individual Tournament on Friday.


Individual Flighted Championship: Individuals are placed in flights based on the players' strength. The draw for the singles and doubles Tournament will be available Thursday afternoon and posted on the Iowa Conference web site at that time.

The Individual Flighted Championship begins at 8:15 a.m. on Friday and Saturday unless the Team Championship is not completed on Thursday. Brackets will be completed through the quarterfinals on Friday with Flight A matches at Coe College, and Flight B and C matches will be at Veterans Park. All Saturday matches will be at Coe.

The Dual Team bracket and season records for players expected to participate in the Conference Championship follow this release.
