IOWA CONFERENCE WOMEN'S TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIP PREVIEW

CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA . . . The 2003 Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IIAC) women's tennis Championship will be held this weekend, October 10-11 in Cedar Rapids. Friday's matches will be played at Clark Racquet Center on the campus of Coe College and Veterans Park Tennis Courts in Cedar Rapids beginning at 9:30 a.m. The location of matches will be determined at the Coaches' Meeting on Thursday evening. All of Saturday's matches will be played at Veterans Park beginning at 9:00 a.m.

Should weather force Friday's action indoors, matches will be played at Coe and at Westfield Tennis Club. Saturday indoor matches will be played at Coe.

Defending Conference Champion, Luther College is the top seed in this year's Championship. The Norse have won 20 of the 21 Iowa Conference women's tennis Championships since 1982. Cornell College, the only other school with an IIAC women's tennis title (2001), is ranked second. Central College is seeded third followed by #4 Coe College, #5 Loras College, #6 Simpson College, #7 Wartburg College and #8 Buena Vista University.

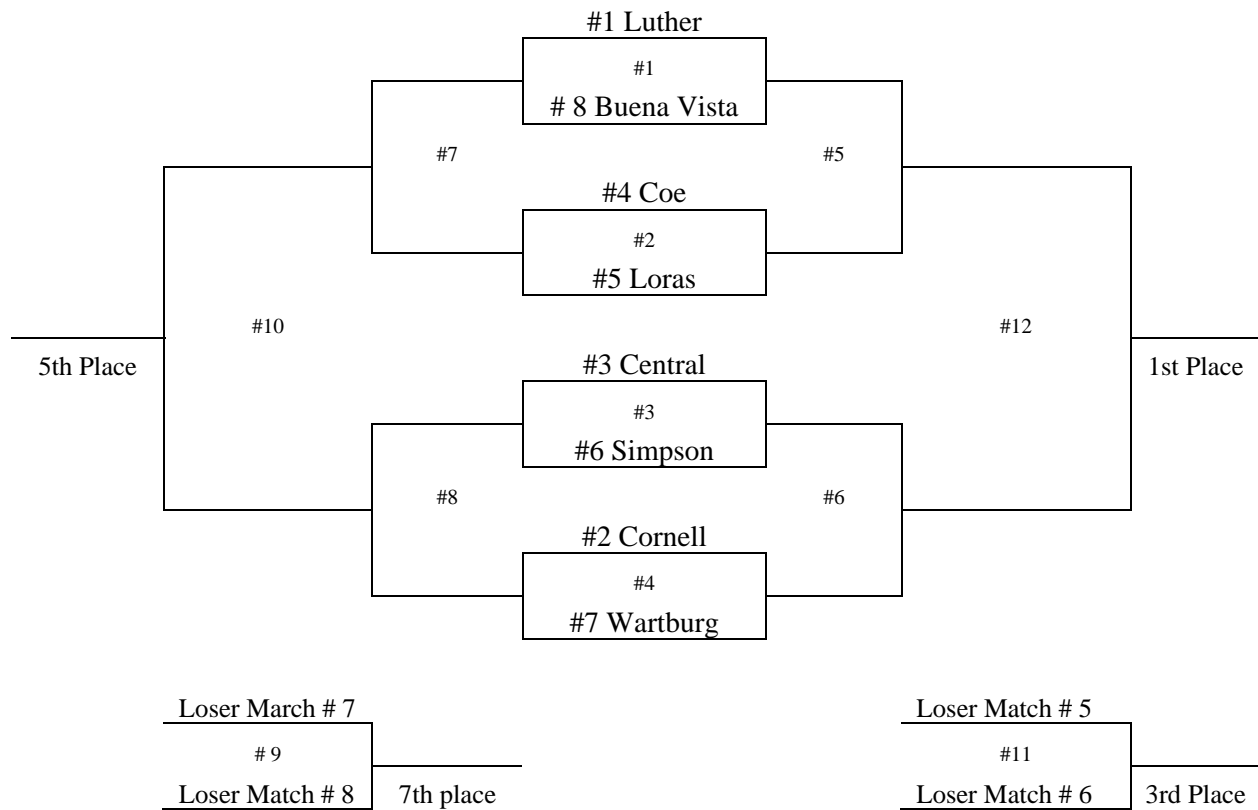

Recap of 2002: In the first year of a team tournament, Luther defeated Cornell, 5-3 in the Championship match. Luther defeated Loras (5-1 in the semifinals) and Buena Vista (6-0 in the quarterfinals) en route to the Championship. Cornell defeated Coe (6-0 in the semifinals) and Wartburg (5-0 in the quarterfinals) en route to the finals.

Loras defeated Coe (5-4) in the third place match, Simpson defeated Central (5-4) in the fifth place match, Wartburg defeated Buena Vista (6-3) in the seventh place match and Upper Iowa defeated Dubuque (6-0) in the ninth place match.
