#### 2004-05 IOWA CONFERENCE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PREVIEW

**CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA...** Defending Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IIAC) Champion Buena Vista University received six of nine first-place votes and accumulated 70 points to claim the top spot in the 2004-05 IIAC Women's Basketball Coaches' Poll. Luther College and Simpson College are tied for second in the preseason poll with 61 points. Luther received two first-place votes and Simpson received one. The complete 2004-05 IIAC Women's Basketball Coaches' Poll follows.

The 2004-05 women's basketball season begins on November 19, with four teams in action that day. Eight schools are scheduled for competition on November 20 and all nine schools will make their season debut by November 22. Conference play begins on Tuesday, November 30, and concludes with the eight-team Conference Tournament on February 22 and 25-26.
