2006 IOWA CONFERENCE SOFTBALL PREVIEW

CEDAR RAPIDS, **IOWA**... Wartburg College, with nine starters and 14 letterwinners returning from last season's 31-8 team, is the pick of the Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IIAC) softball coaches to win the 2006 Conference title.

The Knights received six of nine first-place votes and accumulated 69 points to claim the top spot in the 2006 IIAC softball Coaches' Poll. Defending Conference Champion, Coe College, received two first-place votes and is second in the preseason poll with 64 points. Central College received the other first-place vote, totaled 58 points and is third followed closely by Simpson College (55 points).

Top Returning Players: One former National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) All-American, 11 former NFCA All-Midwest Region players and 21 former All-Conference performers return to their team's line-up this year. Coe senior outfielder **Ashley Wagner**, a two-time All-Conference and All-Region selection as well as a Third Team All-American last year, leads a group of three Kohawk All-Region players back from last year. Senior third baseman **Jana Bradley** and senior first baseman **Chris Engel** both received their second All-Conference honor and were First and Second Team All-Region selections, respectively.

A quartet of Wartburg players – senior pitcher Jackie Sorenson, senior catcher Renae Vomacka, junior second baseman Stephanie Howe and sophomore outfielder Ashley Steines – return as All-Region and All-Conference performers. Howe, Vomacka and Sorensen are two-time All-Region selections, and Vomacka is a two-time All-Conference selection. Sophomore first baseman Ashley Rogers and sophomore designated player Mandy Kakac give the Knights six returning All-Conference players.

Central junior designated player **Tina Shimak** and Simpson junior second baseman **Allison Erichsen** were named to the All-Region Third Team last year and Simpson senior pitcher **Bradi Smith** was named to the All-Region Second Team in 2004. Smith is a two-time All-Conference selection and Shimak was named First Team All-Conference in 2004. Two-time All-Conference outfielder **Erin Michael** of Luther was a 2004 All-Region selection.

Other returning All-Conference performers include: Buena Vista sophomore short stop **Amanda Armstrong**, sophomore utility player **Brandi Sykora** and junior third baseman **Lesley Salton** (2004); Central sophomore catcher **Kelly Harris**, sophomore short stop **Dawn Nissen** and junior left fielder **Laura Anderson** (2004); Loras senior outfielder **Amanda Reiss**, a three-time selection; Luther senior third baseman **Katie Hopp**, a two-time selection; and Simpson sophomore utility player **Calie Hohneke**.

Conference Tournament Introduced: The 2006 season will conclude with the first annual IIAC Softball Tournament to be held in Fort Dodge, Iowa on May 4-6. Buena Vista serves as the host of this year's Tournament at Rogers Sports Complex. The top-six teams in the final regular season standings qualify for the double-elimination Tournament. Additional information will be posted on the Conference web site throughout the season.

New Coaches: Cornell College and the University of Dubuque have new head coaches this spring. **Kevin Kahler** takes over at Cornell for Lori Moss and **Elisha Perkins** takes over at Dubuque for Todd Huffman. Kahler spent three years as head softball coach at Remsen-St. Mary's (Iowa) High School. Perkins served as Dubuque's assistant coach the past two years.
