2005 IOWA CONFERENCE VOLLEYBALL PREVIEW

CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA... Nine-time defending Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IIAC) Champion Central College is the favorite among IIAC coaches to win the 2005 Conference volleyball title. The Dutch received five of seven first-place votes and totaled 53 points, finishing ahead of Wartburg College (47 points, one first-place vote) and Simpson College (44 points, one first-place vote). Preseason National Polls: Central College is ranked 13th in the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) preseason national poll.

The 2005 volleyball season begins on Friday, September 2, with seven schools in action that day. All nine schools take the court on Saturday, September 3. Conference-play begins on Tuesday, September 6, and concludes with a six-team Conference Tournament on November 4-5, at the highest seed. Under a new Conference policy adopted in May, the IIAC volleyball tournament has changed from a nine-team single-elimination tournament at a predetermined site to a six-team single-elimination tournament at the highest seed.
