2005-06 IOWA CONFERENCE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PREVIEW

CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA... Luther College, with three starters and 11 letterwinners returning, is the pick of Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IIAC) women's basketball coaches to win the 2005-06 Conference title, narrowly edging two-time defending Champion Buena Vista University.

Luther received five first-place votes, two second-place votes and a third-place vote for 68 points in the IIAC women's basketball Coaches' Poll. Buena Vista, which also has three starters and 11 letterwinners returning, received the remaining four first-place votes, three second-place votes and a third-place vote for a total of 67 points. Simpson College, winners of the 2005 IIAC Tournament, finished third in the Coaches' Poll with 60 points. The complete 2005-06 IIAC women's basketball Coaches' Poll follows.

Returning All-Conference Performers: Seven former All-Conference performers return to their teams' lineups this year led by 2004-05 Conference Most Valuable Player and three-time All-Conference selection **Katie Maguire**, a senior guard from Buena Vista. In addition to her Conference honors, she was named a Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) honorable mention All-American and a First Team All-Region selection by d3hoops.com.

Maguire's backcourt and classmate **Kelli Staley** and Luther senior forward **Anne Straate** were First Team All-Conference selections last year. Second Team returnees include Central junior center **Ashley Nekola**, Dubuque sophomore guard **Courtney Musser**, Loras sophomore guard/forward **Natalie Pucci** and Luther junior forward **Erica Svien**. Nekola is studying abroad for the fall semester and will not join the Dutch line-up until January.

National Preseason Honors: Buena Vista is ranked in three national preseason polls. The Beavers are ranked 11th by the WBCA and the DIII News, and are 16th in the d3hoops.com poll. Simpson is listed among others receiving votes by the WBCA and d3hoops.com.

Maguire was named to the d3hoops.com Preseason All-American Fourth Team.

New Coaches: Central, Cornell and Loras all have new faces on the sideline. **Natalie Nakic**, the former head coach at Mount Ida College in Boston, takes the helm at Central; **Brent Brase**, the former men's coach at Coe, now leads the Cornell women; and **Shauna Green**, a three-year assistant at Loras, takes over head coaching duties this year.

2005-06 Season: The 2005-06 women's basketball season begins on Friday, November 19. The first Conference game is Tuesday, November 29. IIAC action hits full swing on Wednesday, January 4 and concludes with a six-team Conference Tournament in late February. Under a new Conference policy adopted in May 2005, the IIAC basketball tournaments have changed from an eight-team format to a six-team format with the top two seeds receiving a bye in the first round. The Conference semifinals have also been switched from Friday night to Thursday night. The higher seeded team will host each game.
