IOWA CONFERENCE WOMEN'S GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP PREVIEW

CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA... The 2007 Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IIAC) women's golf Championship begins this weekend, September 28-29, with the first 36-holes of the 72-hole Championship. This weekend's rounds will be played at Pheasant Ridge Golf Club in Cedar Falls, Iowa. The final 36-holes will be played October 5-6, at The Meadows Golf Club in Asbury, Iowa. Friday rounds begin at 10:00 a.m. Saturday rounds begin at 9:00 a.m. Loras College is the host of the 2007 women's golf Championship.

Pairings for play on the first day are determined by team stroke averages. The top four 18-hole scores on courses of at least 5,800 yards will be used to determine team stroke averages. Players from the three teams with the lowest stroke average will play together as will players from the fourth, fifth and sixth ranked teams (based on stroke average) and players from the seventh, eighth and ninth ranked teams.

Pairings for play in rounds two and three will be based on each teams' score position from the previous day. The final round pairings will be determined by individual scores after round three.

Each school may enter five players for each round with the four best performances each day used to determine the team score.

AQ on the Line: Last year, the NCAA expanded the size of the field for the women's golf National Championship and will again award automatic bids to qualifying Conferences. The Iowa Conference women's golf Champion will be the Conference's automatic qualifier to the 2008 NCAA Division III Women's Golf Championship scheduled for May 13-16, 2008, at Centennial Oaks Golf Course in Waverly, Iowa. Iowa Conference member Wartburg is the host institution.

About the 2007 Season: Four Iowa Conference schools have posted top-ten finishes in at least four tournaments this fall. Loras leads the Conference with two tournament titles (Clarke Invitational, Loras Invitational), while defending IIAC champion Wartburg captured a victory at the Luther Fall Invitational. The Knights have the Conference's top team stroke average (332.0) and have finished no worse than fourth in four tournaments. Loras (353.4 average) edges Luther (354.7) for second place in team stroke average, while Simpson, which has four top-ten finishes, has the fourth-best stroke average in the Conference (360.0). Coe has four top-five finishes and ranks fifth in stroke average (364.0).

Individually, Wartburg's **Kate Thompson** has the top stroke average (82.0 average in seven rounds) and has a low round of 79 along with three rounds of 80 and another of 81. Wartburg's **Daina Deery** (82.7 in five rounds), Buena Vista's **Chelsea Anderson** (83.8 in six rounds), Wartburg's **Stephanie Burns** (84.0 in seven rounds) and Simpson's **Katie Vaux** (84.3 in seven rounds) round out the top-five individuals by stroke average on the season.

Vaux, and Coe's **Amanda Nigg** and **Jackie Lerdahl** have posted four top-20 finishes this season. Vaux has four top-20 finishes, three top-10s, and two top-5s including Medalist honors at the Loras Invitational. Nigg has four top-20 finishes, three top-10s, and one top-five. Lerdahl has three top-10s among her four top-20 finishes. Deery (Luther Invitational) and Anderson (Central Invitational) are the other Conference golfers to earn Medalist honors in addition to Vaux. Thompson enters the Tournament with three consecutive top-five finishes after opening the season with a 26th-place finish at the UW-Eau Claire Invitational.

Deery has the Conference's three lowest rounds of the season, shooting 76 twice (Wartburg Invitational, Luther Invitational) and 77 once (UW-Eau Claire Invitational). Seven other golfers have broken 80 this season. Loras' **Brooke Davis** shot a 78 at the Wartburg Invitational, while Burns posted a 78 at the Luther Invitational. Thompson and

Wartburg's **Ellen Rickert** each shot a 79 at the Wartburg Invitational, Anderson posted a 79 to win the Central Invitational, Loras' **Amy Kemp** shot a 79 at the Illinois Wesleyan Fall Classic, and Vaux recorded a 79 at the Luther Invitational.

Complete team and individual scoring averages follow this release.

2006 Championship Recap: Simpson College won its IIAC-record ninth women's golf Championship firing a 72-hole total 1321, outdistancing two-time defending champion Wartburg by six strokes to win its first Conference title since 2002 and earn the Conference's inaugural automatic bid to the NCAA Division III Women's Golf Championship. Buena Vista's **Jennifer Stork** took home individual Medalist honors after posting four rounds in the 70s and shooting an IIAC 72-hole Championship record 306 (75-76-77-78).

Stork broke the Conference's previous 72-hole low of 314 set in 2005 by Wartburg's **Erin Dohlman**. Stork finished nine strokes ahead of Wartburg's **Andrea Schiltz**, who was second at 72-75-84-84—315. Following a scorecard tie-breaker, Kemp (81-77-82-89—329) finished third and Vaux (78-74-82-95—329) finished fourth.

A scorecard tie-breaker gave Central's **Sharilyne Hoekstra** (74-82-88-86—330) fifth-place and Simpson's **Jess Harvey** (78-76-87-89—330) sixth-place. Brooke Davis (331), Wartburg's **Megan Cress** (334) and Simpson's **Megan Smith** (337) finished seventh, eighth and ninth, respectively. Simpson's **Noel Treibel** (339) defeated Thompson on the first hole of a sudden death playoff to finish 10th and round out the All-Conference honorees.

Top Returning Individuals: Eleven of the top-20 finishers from 2006 return to their teams' line-up for this year's Conference Championship, including five All-Conference performers (top-10 finish). Loras' Kemp and Davis are among 40 lowa Conference women's golfers with two top-10 finishes at the Conference Championship and with another can join 18 others that have three top-10 finishes. Kemp, last year's third-place finisher with a 329, finished 10th in 2005 with a 342. Davis, who placed seventh last year with a 331, tied for 10th in 2004 with a 335 while golfing for Wartburg.

Other returning top-20 finishers from 2006 include: Thompson (11th, 339), Derry (t-12th, 341), Coe's **Angela Meisterling** (t-12th, 341), Loras' **Steph Schwartz** (t-12th, 341), Luther's **Amy Ekland** (19th, 348) and Coe's Amanda Nigg (20th, 349).

A trio Simpson golfers – Vaux (4th, 329), Smith (9th, 337) and Treibel (10th, 339) – return with All-Conference honors to their credit from last season, while Thompson and Luther's **Lindsay Thies** earned All-Conference honors in 2005.

Probable Line-ups: Probable line-ups for the Conference Championship are listed below. Teams with more than five golfers are still holding competition to determine its Championship line-up. Bolded players have previously competed in the Iowa Conference Championship. Buena Vista has only three golfers and will not be eligible for the team championship.
