IOWA CONFERENCE WOMEN'S GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP PREVIEW

CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA... The 2009 Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IIAC) Women's Golf Championship begins this weekend, September 25-26, with the first 36-holes of the 72-hole Championship. This weekend's rounds will be played at Pheasant Ridge Golf Club in Cedar Falls, Iowa. The final 36-holes will be played October 2-3, at Oneota Golf and Country Club in Decorah. Friday rounds begin at 10:00 a.m. Saturday rounds begin at 9:00 a.m. Luther College is the host of the 2009 Women's Golf Championship.

Pairings for play on the first day are determined by team stroke averages. The top four 18-hole scores on courses of at least 5,800 yards will be used to determine team stroke averages. Players from the three teams with the lowest stroke average (Central, Simpson, Wartburg) will play together as will players from the fourth, fifth and sixth ranked teams (Loras, Coe, Luther) and players from the seventh, eighth and ninth ranked teams (Buena Vista, Cornell, Dubuque).

Pairings for play in rounds two and three will be based on each teams' score position from the previous day. The final round pairings will be determined by individual scores after round three.

Each school may enter five players for each round with the four best performances each day used to determine the team score.

AQ on the Line: In 2007, the NCAA expanded the size of the field for the Division III Women's Golf Championship and will again award automatic bids to qualifying conferences. The Iowa Conference women's golf champion will be the IIAC's automatic qualifier to the 2010 NCAA Division III Women's Golf Championship scheduled for May 11-14, 2010, at the Mission Inn Resort in Howey-in-the-Hills, Fla. Oglethorpe University is the host institution.

About the 2009 Season: Four Iowa Conference schools have posted top-three finishes in a tournament this fall. Loras has the only tournament title (Loras Fall Invitational), while Wartburg has two runner-up finishes (Wartburg, DIII Midwest Classic) and a third-place finish (Central) and Central took second at their own meet and third at Wartburg. Coe has the only other top-three finish with a runner-up placing at the Loras Fall Invitational. The Knights have the Conference's top team stroke average (333.2) and have finished no worse than third in three tournaments. Simpson (344.7 average) edges Central (345.6) for second place in team stroke average. Luther, which has finished in the top-11 at each of its tournaments, has the fourth-best scoring average (360.5), followed by Coe (373.8).

Individually, Central's **Sarah Paulson** has the top stroke average (77.8 average in six rounds) and has a low round of 75 along with two rounds of 77 and two more of 79. Wartburg's **Ellen Rickert** (80.5 average in six rounds), Simpson's **Katie Vaux** (82.2 average in six rounds), Central's **Eva Downes** (83.0 in six rounds), and Wartburg's **Daina Deery** (83.3 in six rounds) round out the top-five individuals by stroke average on the season. Wartburg's **Jordan Galles** ranks percentage points behind Deery after compiling an 83.5 average (501 strokes in six rounds).

Central's Paulson has three top-10 finishes, including capturing medalist honors at the Central Invitational. She was also fourth at Wartburg and Illinois Wesleyan. Rickert captured medalist honors at Wartburg, followed by Downes in second. Vaux also tied for fifth in a tough field at the Division III Midwest Classic. Loras' **Abby Potts** captured medalist honors at the Loras Invitational, while Coe's **Courtney Williams** posted the low round in a season-opening dual with Cornell.

Paulson has three of the Conference's 12 lowest rounds this fall, shooting 75 at the Illinois Wesleyan Fall Classic and firing back-to-back 77s at the Wartburg Invitational. Downes and Rickert share the Conference's low round of the fall, each posting 73s during the first round of the Wartburg Invitational. In addition, Rickert posted rounds of 76 (Midwest Classic, 1st round) and 77 (Wartburg, 2nd round). Galles has two of the league's top rounds, firing a 76 at Wartburg and a 77 at the Division III Midwest Classic. Three Simpson golfers have also broken 78 this season – Vaux and **Megan Smith** fired 76s and **Taylor Hillery** added a 77, all during the Midwest Classic.

Complete team and individual scoring averages follow this release.

2008 Championship Recap: Wartburg College won its fourth IIAC Women's Golf Championship in five years with 72-hole total of 1290, a commanding 53 shots ahead of Central College and Luther College. The Knights also earned the Conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Division III Women's Golf Championship. Central freshman **Sarah Paulson** took home individual medalist honors with a 72-hole total of 306 (76-71-81-78), including a Championship-record 71 in round two. The Knights were able to fire the final day's low team score of 329 and take the title by 53 strokes. Wartburg's margin of victory was the second largest in tournament history, exceeded only by the Knights' 69-stroke victory over Buena Vista in 2005.

Paulson's four-day total of 306 tied the low 72-hole individual total in Conference Championship history. Buena Vista's Jen

Stork also fired a 306 in 2006. She finished eight strokes ahead of 2007 medalist **Steph Burns** of Wartburg, who posted a total of 75-81-77-81—314. Simpson's **Katie Vaux** (82-76-80-79—317) took third, seven shots ahead of Wartburg's **Kate Thompson** (81-81-83-79—324). Vaux and Thompson are three-time All-Conference performers. Vaux took fourth in 2006 and ninth in 2007, while Thompson was seventh in 2005 and sixth in 2006.

Luther's **Amy Ekland** (81-76-88-82—327) edged Wartburg's **Daina Deery** (75-88-82-83—328) for fifth place by a stroke, and Central's Eva Downes (79-79-86-87—331) was seventh.

A scorecard tie-breaker gave Luther's **Lindsay Thies** (84-84-83-81—332) eighth place over Loras' **Jackie Kieffer** (82-85-86-79—332) and Simpson's **Megan Smith** (81-86-82-90—339) took tenth place and the final All-Conference position by beating Wartburg's **Ellen Rickert** (90-78-85-86—339) on the second playoff hole. Thies and Smith also became three-time All-Conference honorees with their finishes. Thies placed ninth in 2005 and seventh in 2007, while Smith took ninth in 226 and fourth in 2007.

Top Returning Individuals: Eleven of the top-20 finishers from 2008 return to their teams' line-up for this year's Conference Championship, including five All-Conference performers (top-10 finish). Simpson's Vaux and Smith are among 38 Iowa Conference women's golfers with at least three top-10 finishes at the Conference Championship and with another can join the 14 who posted top-10 finishes in each year of eligibility. Vaux finished third last season (317) after placing ninth in 2007 (340) and fourth in 2006 (329). Smith won a two-hole playoff to finish tenth last season (339) after finishing fourth in 2007 (334) and ninth in 2006 (337).

Other returning top-20 finishers from 2008 include: Wartburg's **Ellen Rickert** (11th, 339), Luther's **Emily Looft** (t-12th, 342), Coe' **Jackie Lerdal** (14th, 345) and **Caitlin Johnson** (20th, 360), Simpson's **Taylor Hillery** (17th, 352), and Loras' **Brittney Boffeli** (18th, 357). Paulson (medalist, 306), Deery (6th, 328), Downes (7th, 331), and Looft (5th in 2007, 335) also return with All-Conference honors to their credit from past seasons.
