**Kelsie Allen, Luther College, Eagan, Minn./Eastview**

Allen, a senior, posted three victories to lead Luther to its league-record 24th IIAC women's tennis title. In a 5-0 semifinal victory over Wartburg, she teamed with Brynne Zinnecker for an 8-5 victory at No. 1 singles over Molly Eslick and Leanna Nelson. In the championship match against Coe, Allen and Zinnecker topped Andrea Schupbach and Michelle Schupbach by a 8-6 score. Allen provide the clinching point with a 6-4, 6-4 win over Hannah Jensen at No. 1 singles.

## IOWA CONFERENCE WOMEN'S TENNIS INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIP PREVIEW

**CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA . . .** The 2009 Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (IIAC) Women's Tennis Championship continues this weekend with the Flighted Individual Tournament at Clark Racquet Center on the campus of Coe College in Cedar Rapids and the Small Multi-Sport Center on the campus of Cornell College in Mount Vernon. All nine Conference schools will participate in the Individual Tournament.

***Flighted Individual Tournament:*** Individuals are placed in flights based on the players' strength. The draw for the singles and doubles tournaments will be attached and have been posted on the Iowa Conference web site.

The Flighted Individual Tournament begins at 8 p.m. Thursday evening at Clark Racquet Center with first round play in Flight B doubles. Doubles play continues Friday, starting at 8 a.m. with Flight A play at Coe and Flight B play at Cornell. Singles will follow with Flight A and the top half of Flight B being contested at Coe and Flight C and the bottom half of Flight B being held in Mount Vernon. Brackets will be completed through the quarterfinals in all flights Friday. Weather permitting, all of Saturday's matches will be held at Coe's Clark Racquet Center. Any changes will be posted on the Iowa Conference web site at [www.iowaconference.com](http://www.iowaconference.com).

Quarterfinalists in Flight A singles and semifinalists in Flight A doubles receive All-Conference honors.

***2008 Individual Tournament Recap:*** 2007 Flight A singles runner-up **Hannah Jensen** of Coe captured the 2008 title, defeating Wartburg's **Molly Eslick**, 6-1, 6-2, in the semifinals before topping Luther's **Kelsie Allen**, 6-3, 6-0, in the championship match. Allen advanced to the final with a 6-2, 6-0 victory in her semifinal match with Central's **Hilary Baehr**. Baehr defeated Eslick, 6-1, 7-6 (2), for third place.

Simpson's **Alissa Nance** captured the title in Flight B singles, needing a third set to top Central's **Emily Swartz**, 3-6, 6-3, 1-0 (5). Nance advanced to the final with a 6-1, 6-4 win over Luther's **Laura Reutlinger**, while Swartz topped Luther's **Katie Patterson** by a 6-2, 6-2 score. Patterson won the all-Norse third-place match, 6-3, 6-1.

Flight C singles saw an all-Simpson championship match-up pitting **Gwen Kingsbury** against **Lynae Gruber**. Kingsbury prevailed, 6-1, 6-0. In the third-place match, Central's **Brigitte Newman** topped Dubuque's **Jacqueline Ventrice**, 6-0, 6-2.

In Flight A doubles, Jensen and **Katy Delagardelle** posted wins over Central tandems in both the semifinals and final to take the title and give Jensen a second championship on the day. In the semifinals, the Coe duo defeated **Faith Bliss** and **Kayla Donner**, 8-5, then topped Hilary Baehr and **Stephanie Gibbons** by an 8-2 margin. Baehr/Gibbons advanced to the final with a hard-fought 8-6 win over Luther's **Brynne Zinnecker** and Kelsie Allen. Zinnecker/Allen beat Bliss/Donner, 8-2, for third place.

Central's **Katie Williamson** and Emily Swartz captured the Flight B doubles crown with an 8-5 win over Luther's **Sara Dale** and Katie Patterson. Dale and Patterson defeated Cornell's **Annabelle Milliken** and **Amanda Johnson** 8-3 in one semifinal, while Williamson and Swartz topped Simpson's Alissa Nance and **Jackie Suckow** 8-5 in the other. The Cornell tandem captured third place with an 8-4 victory.

***Top Returning Individuals:*** Eleven players that earned All-Conference honors in 2008 return for this year's Individual Tournament. Coe's **Hannah Jensen** captured the 2008 title in Flight A singles but is seeded second in this year's meet. **Kelsie Allen** of Luther, the 2008 Flight A runner-up, secured the top seed by virtue of a win over Jensen at last weekend's IIAC Team Championship. Wartburg's **Molly Eslick**, who sports a 20-1 singles record, is seeded third after a fourth-place finish last season.

Coe's **Andrea Schupbach**, a two-time All-Conference selection in singles, is seeded fourth, followed by teammates **Hillary Allen** (sixth) and **Michelle Schupbach** (eighth). Luther's **Fran Fairfield** and **Brynne Zinnecker** are seeded fifth and seventh, respectively. Allen is looking to earn All-Conference honors in singles for the fourth time in her career but could potentially face two former All-Conference players en route to the quarterfinals. A potential second round match with 2007 quarterfinalist **Alana Humpal** of Luther looms if she can get past 2006 All-Conference selection **Alisha Espey** (2nd, No. 4 singles) of Loras in the first round. **Katie Nichols** (QF, 2008) and **Faith Bliss** (2nd, No. 5 singles, 2006) are other former All-Conference singles players in the Flight A singles draw.

Five of last year's eight quarterfinalists in Flight B singles return, but only two return to the same draw as Central's **Sara Dale** and **Emily Swartz** (runner-up) and **Katie Patterson** (third-place) have moved up to Flight A. One of the other two, Simpson's **Jill Berner**, was awarded the top seed in Flight B, while Luther's **Laura Reutlinger**, last year's fourth place finisher, also returns.

In Flight C, 2008 runner-up **Lynae Gruber** of Simpson and third-place finisher **Jackie Ventrice** of Dubuque return to compete for a title.

In Flight A doubles, **Andrea Schupbach**, also a two-time All-Conference selection and 2006 Flight A champion in doubles, pairs with younger sister **Michelle**, and are the flight's top seed. Luther's **Kelsie Allen** and **Brynne Zinnecker**, third in Flight A a year ago, are the No. 2 seeds. Allen is attempting to earn All-Conference honors in doubles for the fourth consecutive year. Molly Eslick and **Leanna Nelson** of Wartburg are the No. 3 seed, while 2008 fourth-place finishers **Faith Bliss** and **Kayla Donner** of Central are seeded fourth.

Two-time All-Conference doubles player **Hannah Jensen** of Coe will look to earn all-league honors with her third different doubles partner in as many years. She is playing with **Megan Fiala** this year after winning the Flight A title with **Katy Delagardelle** last year and finishing second in 2007 with **Hillary Allen**. Jensen/Fiala is in Allen/Zinnecker's quarter of the bracket, but must get past Central's **Sara Dale** and **Stephanie Gibbons** in the first round. Gibbons finished second in Flight A in 2008 pairing with Hilary Baehr.

Cornell's **Caryl Abeyta** is the remaining returning All-Conference doubles player, capturing third place with **Pavla Brachova** in 2007. She is paired with **Kirsten Lasley** in this year's tournament and will face Luther's **Cami Czech** and **Elise Allen** in the first round with the winner to face the Schupbach sisters in the second round.

In Flight B, eight of 16 quarterfinalists are back, but none are playing with their partner from 2008. **Emily Swartz** of Central, one-half of last year's first-place tandem, returns and will contest this year's tournament with fellow quarterfinalist **Trinh Le**. Of last year's runner-up duo, **Sara Dale** now competes for Central and will play in Flight A, while **Katie Patterson** will take to the court with **Carrie Eisele**, another 2008 quarterfinalist.
